

# TZAMID Seminar Children with disabilities in the Scouts Movement

Next summer, hundreds of scouts in Israel will join a special seminar for group leaders of scouts with special needs. The seminar was built according to the needs of TZAMID (Special needs in scouting) training, with an emphasis on providing training tools, integration concept and creating emotional readiness to meet with a population with special needs.

### **Short description:**

The seminar goal is to train position holders working with children and youth with disabilities.

The seminar will include base content, training programs and enrichment programs designed to help participants shape their own role and perform it in the best way.

The seminar will be held in a hostel with all meals served in the same place.

#### Host

The seminar is organized by the department for scouts with special needs in the Hebrew Scouts Movement in Israel and the international group will be accompanied by the international department.

We recommend planning a longer trip in Israel and staying before or after the seminar!

#### Venue:

The seminar will be held in Ayanot Youth Village (http://www.ayanot.org.il) and a shuttle will take participants from Tel-Aviv to the village and back.

### Participants' Profile

The "TZAMID" seminar is an event for Scouts aged between 17 and 24. International participants can also be older. All participants should be active members of their respective Scout organizations and have previous experience in overnights hikes.

## Security

The seminar is approved by the Israeli police, Israeli Defense Force, Education Minister and the Scout movement.

#### Registration

Participants can register online until 1 June 2014.

#### **Applications**

Israel Scouts will be applying to the EuroMed program, in order to get funding for the international participants and cover 70% of the international transportation and the whole amount of the participation fee for a maximum of 12 international participants.

That means that you will only have to pay 30% of your tickets to our country and nothing else!
